The Intensive Summer Course in Arabic for Speakers of Other Languages

The Unit of Teaching Arabic to Speakers of Other Languages places at your disposal its specialised staff and its long and accumulated experience so that you can acquire the skills of speaking, reading and writing Modern Standard Arabic in various contexts and different domains, and know about the major components of Arabic culture, thus contributing to the establishment of communication links between numerous civilizations.

To achieve these goals, the Unit opted for a comprehensive pedagogical methodology which adopts an efficient audio-visual approach in learning language skills, based on:

- Specialised textbooks,
- Tapes and CDs,
- Electronic equipment...

*The course comprises both language lessons and other activities.

*The term starts with a placement test (except for beginners) aiming at determining the participants' levels and assigning them to the appropriate groups.

*Groups are organised into four levels:

- Level 1: includes two sub-levels (A and B);
- Level 2: includes two sub-levels (A and B);
- Level 3;
- Level 4.

*Groups include 10 to 15 students

*Each group is supervised by two teachers; one for morning lessons, and another for afternoon activities.

*Duration of morning lessons: 4 hours (from Monday to Friday)

*Duration of afternoon lessons: 2 hours (Tuesday and Thursday)

*Other activities, organised in coordination with participants, include trips and cultural workshops about topics such as the Moroccan wedding, food...

* The course ends with a party during which participants get Certificates that attest their attendance as well as the attained level and degree.
